
Coming Soon

Better Lighting in the Sanctuary

An improvement that wasn't even an official part of the Project Renew plan, but was inspired by your input for it, is to improve lighting in the sanctuary. We have replaced the incandescent bulbs with higher lumen, dimmable LED bulbs. They are brighter, cleaner, and so much more efficient that they should pay themselves off in one year and save the congregation \$500 per year thereafter. A big thanks to Maury Martin for replacing the bulbs and also changing the broken dimmer in the sound room!



A final note

Coming up, we anticipate several volunteer opportunities, including building a shed and reupholstering the pews. As the renovations take place, we will need people to help move furniture and "final clean" the building.
