

Trinity Lutheran Church Christian Camp Scholarship

Trinity Lutheran Church has a history of supporting our young people who attend a church camp. This tradition has changed over the years, from taking middle school students to camp as a group to offering scholarship help for our youth. This year, the church council continues to encourage our youth to strengthen their faith by attending a Christian based summer camp.

As there is a financial commitment to attend these types of events, Trinity Lutheran Church is offering a scholarship with a *maximum* of \$150 per child or \$500 per family. (Award amounts will be announced after we know the number of qualifying applicants) Funding for this scholarship will come from the proceeds of our Annual Easter Breakfast. Scholarships will be awarded annually based on the application requirements and on a first come, first served basis until the funds are depleted for the year.

Since the funding of the scholarship comes from the proceeds from special fundraising events, we prefer that applicants volunteer for the Easter Breakfast. If that was not possible, some other volunteering or service to the Church may be done instead with the approval of the Pastor and Office Administrator. In addition, we ask that each scholarship recipient share with the council a brief summary (written or verbal) about their camp experience within a month of the event.
