Bible Stories of the Month

The Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:5-15)

Jesus gave us The Lord's Prayer to let us know that God wants us to talk to Him each day, through prayer, and to share what's on our hearts. Prayer is a simple, but also complex, topic for kids. It is important to talk about how prayer is an easy thing anyone can do every day. Also, consistently model prayer for kids by praying aloud with with them at home using language that is simple so kids can learn that prayers don't need to be elaborate. They should know that their prayers are important and that they don't have to be an adult to talk to God.

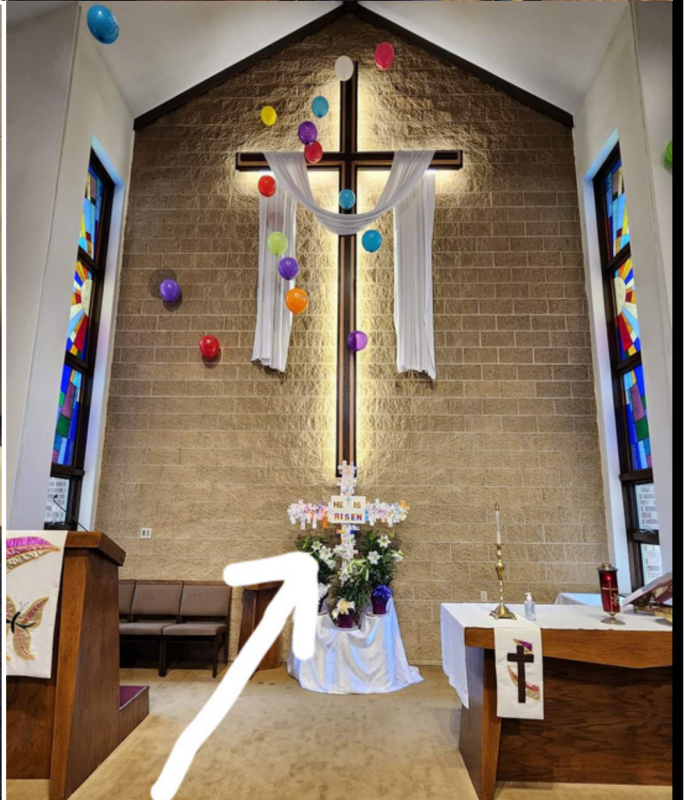

Tips for incorporating Sunday School and this month's stories as a family

- 2. Conversation Starter:** How and when does God answer prayers?
